3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Prevent Lockout of  
5 Athletes this Year Act of 2011”.

1 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS.**

2 Act of September 30, 1961, commonly known as the  
3 Sports Broadcasting Act of 1961, is amended—

4 (1) in the 1st sentence of the 1st section by  
5 striking “football,” each place it appears,

6 (2) in section 4 by striking “football,” and

7 (3) in section 6 by striking “football.”
